South Pasadena High School's first class graduated in 1907 but it wasn't until 1909 that students published their first yearbook, Copa de Oro. With the exception of 1918*, a Copa was published every year thereafter. There are currently 103 years of Copas and the SPHSAA has set a goal of collecting three complete sets of Copas for our archives. One set will be digitally preserved, which will begin this year.

We do have a number of Copas for various years, however, we currently do not have a complete set for all 103 years. While Copas are occasionally for sale on various online sources or through other organizations, to obtain our complete set we are relying on donations. We've received several donated Copas in the last few months from alumni and alumni family members who no longer have a need to keep them in their collection. These donations are very much appreciated.

2012 Grand Reunion IV

The South Pasadena Alumni Association held its fourth "Grand Reunion" on Saturday, June 16. The event, which occurs once every decade, was held on the South Pasadena High School campus and open to all alumni of the school.

Alumni convened in the auditorium at 8:00 A.M. for a brief orientation. South Pasadena Mayor, Michael A. Cacciotti encouraged them to spend time rediscovering the city and the school.

After the orientation, attendees were released to the soccer field, where various activities and exhibits were hosted. A large portion of the field was dedicated to a group of tents, each designated to a specific decade, designed to aid alumni in finding and reconnecting with former classmates from their era.

Other tents housed silent auctions for old *Copa de Oro* yearbooks and SPHS memorabilia sold by the Booster Club, as well as tents dedicated to South Pasadena history. The history tents held older photographs that gave alumni a chance to share a moment with their former school.

"They changed the building but they kept the tradition," said SPHS alumna Margaret Rae Lackie.

Throughout the day, alumni were reconnecting with former classmates. Jim Kiefer (Class of 1964), the school's long jump record holder, found his former high school neighbor, Nancy Mann (Class of 1962), sparking

a conversation about high school between old friends.

"I recall the teachers were really good. They stretched you intellectually," Mann said.

A second assembly was held later in the day, during which SPHS principal Ms Janet Anderson and former Athletic Director Mr. Ralph Punaro presented awards to ten students and two coaches.

Attendees were given the added option to attend a breakfast the following morning at the Arroyo Seco Café to further reconnect with old classmates.

Mary Ida Knight Phair

1920 - 2012



Mary Ida Knight Phair '38 was born in Amarillo, Texas on October 23, 1920. She died from complications of pneumonia on November 9, 2012, at her residence in Regents Point, Irvine, California. Her family was at her bedside.

At age seven, Mary Ida and her family moved to Southern California. They settled in South Pasadena where she would spend the next 50 years. During that period she would go through the local school system, marry schoolmate Bob Phair (SPHS '37) in 1941, and

help raise Rob (SPHS '63) and Randy (SPHS '67), their two sons.

Mary Ida decided to continue her higher education. Her first priority was always family, but she somehow managed to graduate from college (UCLA, CSULA) in 1961 and go on to receive her masters degree from USC Library School. One week later she was hired at her alma mater, South Pasadena High School, and was in that position for the next 20 years. She received many awards and accolades. She seemed to be most proud of organizing the Grand Reunion of 75 years of classes in 1982. Approximately 7,000 alumni came from all over the world and participated in a parade through downtown. The part she seemed to enjoy most was that nobody thought it could be done. It got done and in grand fashion. When she retired they named the library/media center the Mary Ida Phair Media Center. It remains so today.

After retirement, she and Bob moved to Dana Point. She remained active as a docent for the San Juan Capistrano Mission, Dana Point Historical Society, and the Ocean Institute. In 2003 she moved to Regents Point in Irvine. Mary Ida was an inspiration. She accomplished many wonderful things. She volunteered to be a Girl Scout leader when they couldn't find someone, even though she only had two boys. On a lark she decided to coach the high school girl's field hockey team. Her greatest joy was her family, first and foremost. She was a positive and optimistic person. She was generous with her time, her intelligence, and her love. Mary Ida was a born teacher who loved to mentor people: from encouraging her sons every inch of the way; to helping students realize their potential; more recently, to helping employees at Regents Point learn the English language.

Mary Ida was predeceased by husband Bob in 1998, son Randy in 1995; brothers James Knight (SPHS '37) and Luther Knight (SPHS '41); and sister Jeanette Claycamp (SPHS '43). She is survived by her son Rob; daughter-in-law Randa; three grandchildren, Rory, Luke, and Eden; Tim (Rory's husband); and four great-grandchildren, Will, Luke, Jack, and Kate.

Mary Ida's Grand Idea

Over the years since my high school days the faculty had changed. In the 60's they were younger, there were men and women, many with families, but the dedication was still there. South Pas continued to be a fine high school.

Eventually I began thinking about a grand celebration to show the current students and everyone else what an outstanding school SPHS is. I thought it would be good to invite all graduates, beginning from the first graduating class of 1907. The more I thought about the idea, the more excited I became. All of a sudden I realized that maybe this idea was bigger than I could handle alone. We needed an Alumni Association to plan this Grand Reunion and maintain future contact with all the school's alumni. Luckily I found a few other faithful Tigers who also thought the idea was a good one and a committee was formed.

Our goals were to celebrate seventy-five years of the school's history and to create a database including the

names of all alumni of our school. Our search resulted in a large stack of computer printouts and hundreds of "IBM cards" with comments from alumni.

The idea to invite the earliest alumni we could find was agreed upon. The last remaining member of that first class of six members, Edna Faye Mungor Goldman, came from Arizona to be our homecoming queen. Among the 6000 or so alumni attending were two California congressmen: John Rousselot, R-San Marino and Paul McCloskey, R-Menlo Park. Both graduated from SPSMHS Class of 1945. South Pasadena High School was the only one in the country with two members of congress. The congressmen brought a flag to the celebration that had flown over the White House.
