# More Than \$300,000 in Bequests Launches Endowed Scholarship Program

An idea that began as the "pipe dream" of two SPHSAA Board members has become an exciting reality for our alumni association. Generous gifts from the estates of Keith L. Stiles (Class of 1944) and former SPHS English and Journalism teacher Barbara Ercek have established the *South Pasadena High School Alumni Association Endowed Scholarship Fund*, which will ensure that graduating seniors from SPHS will continue to have the opportunity to attend college in perpetuity.

Board members Bill Kloezeman and Bill Peters were concerned that the Association's annual scholarships, which have historically been funded 100% by member dues and gifts that are collected during the year, might eventually prove inadequate to fund the college educations of deserving SPHS graduates. They dreamed of an endowed scholarship fund in which the principal assets would be maintained in conservative investments, and the interest generated would support the Association's annual scholarship contributions. However, given the relatively low level of annual revenues, which barely cover the Association's modest annual gifts, there was no obvious source of funding with which to establish an endowment program.

However, the two Bills' dream began to take shape in late 2010 when the Board was contacted by the executor of the Estate of Keith L. Stiles. The attorney notified us that Mr. Stiles, a 1944 graduate from South Pasadena High School, had left four percent (4%) of his estate to the Alumni Association as a gift on behalf of himself and in the name of his mother, Mildred Keith Stiles, a member SPHS's Class of 1910. The

first portion of the Stiles Estate gift, totaling \$3,500, was received in December 2011, and the balance is expected in 2012.

Then, in September 2011, the Association was contacted by an attorney for the Estate of Barbara Lou Ercek, an outstanding SPHS English and Journalism teacher in the 1960's and 1970's. Mrs. Ercek believed in the power of education to change the lives of young people, and she wanted to see her late husband's and her estate used to support that cause. Her attorney advised us that Ms. Ercek had given her entire estate, worth more than \$300,000, to the Alumni Association for the expressed purpose of establishing an endowed scholarship fund to help SPHS graduates obtain a college education.

These benevolent gestures, by a former teacher and a former student, lead the way in establishing what we hope will become a significant revenue source for helping our Tiger grads pursue their dreams of obtaining an undergraduate education. Our goal is to raise \$1,000,000 for the endowment by encouraging Tiger alumni to make even a modest bequest from their estate plans. Gifts can be made in the name of the grantor and/or other family members that have attended SPHS, and may even memorialize favorite teachers, coaches, administrators or others.

We are very excited about the new endowment fund and would be happy to assist or provide information for SPHS alumni that are interested in contributing to the program. # SPHSAA Endowment Fund Founding Donors Touched The Lives of Many

Keith L. Stiles, Class of 1944

Keith Leonard Stiles was born nearby and raised in South Pasadena by his parents, Conrad and Mildred Stiles. Keith developed an early interest in amateur "ham" radio, and was licensed to operate station W6SHD (later W7IZQ) starting in 1938 when he was twelve years old. He graduated from SPHS in June 1944, and then enlisted in the U.S. Army for a short period of service near the end of World War II.

After the war, Keith returned home and attended Occidental College in Los Angeles, graduating with a B.A. in economics. While he attended Oxy, Keith was the editor of the school paper, *The Occidental*, and met his first wife, Eleanor. The couple was married in June 1950, and they lived in Pasadena, where Keith worked in the military electronics field, and raised their two sons, Bill and Tom.

In 1972, the family moved to Cottage Grove, Oregon, and acquired commercial radio station KNND, which played a mix of country & western and contemporary music. Tragically, Eleanor passed away a short time after the family moved to Oregon, and Keith sold the radio station and moved to Bellevue, Washington, resuming his work in military electronics. During his Oregon radio association, Keith met Marilyn Lee Wagner, and they were married in July 1974.

Keith and Lee moved to the Key Peninsula in the Puget Sound area of Washington in 1977. Keith retired in 1983 and began volunteer service as the Editor of the Key Peninsula News, a member of the Friends of the Key Center Library, and a member and President of the Peninsula School Board. He was also one of the founders of Gig Harbor's radio station, KGHP, and served as the station's chief engineer. Keith and Lee led the successful effort to restore the historic name of "Joemma Beach" to the nearby State Park on the Key Peninsula.

After Lee passed away in January 2005, Keith remained active, supporting the Key Peninsula Fire Protection District, and serving as a columnist for the Key Peninsula *Gateway* newspaper. He also continued to enjoy his lifelong pastime as a ham radio operator. Keith passed away in Gig Harbor, Washington on October 19, 2010, at the age of 84, leaving his two sons and their families.



## Barbara Lou Ercek, SPHS Teacher, 1960's to 1970's

Barbara L. Ercek is remembered by her students at SPHS as "a class-act teacher, of the utmost professional demeanor." Ms. Ercek taught English and Journalism at the high school during the 1960's and 1970's, and she established "impeccable standards for accuracy, fairness and balance" for her students.

In a glowing remembrance posted on the Alumni Association website, Betty Millsaps van Iersel, SPHS Class of 1966, wrote:

"Of the many superb teachers I was privileged to have at SPHS, none were as instrumental in my life and career as Barbara Ercek, who taught English and journalism. As editor of *The Tiger* in my senior year (1965-1966), I knew Mrs. Ercek well, and it was she who helped me focus on a career in journalism and public affairs, my college majors and my life's work.

"A native 'Hoosier' and proud alumna of Indiana University, she embodied the best values and virtues of the American Midwest: a direct, unassuming manner; a stellar work ethic; a plain-spoken, honest style; and a passion for her craft. She really knew her stuff! Unlike many high school journalism teachers whose first love is English literature, Barbara was a journalist first, and her passion showed...

"On a personal level, Barbara and her husband, Chuck, lived a short distance from my home, and I would frequently spend afternoons with them, particularly in summer. I remember 'hanging' around their patio and breakfast bar and, within appropriate boundaries, being treated as an equal, rather than a kid. They never condescended, always encouraged. I probably barraged her for letters of recommendation, which as a college communications professor, I've paid forward many times over.

"In fact, there are few days when I haven't thought of how fortunate I was to have known Barbara and all of my teachers at SPHS ... all had a lasting impact upon my enduring passion for the English language, world and national affairs and French language and culture. While I appreciated all of them at the time, it was many years before I fully recognized how well prepared I was for college and for life because of my fine public high school education. Having spent most of my adult life on the East Coast in New England and Washington, DC, I've worked and sometimes competed with colleagues from elite educational backgrounds, and I always felt that my preparation equaled or exceeded theirs."

After dedicating her career to developing the minds of her students, Barbara Ercek left nearly \$300,000 in her estate to the Alumni Association for the purpose of establishing an endowed scholarship program, ensuring that many other young minds will have the opportunity to attend college. This founding endowment helps the SPHSAA accomplish a goal we have had for several years, and assures that we will always have funding available to provide annual scholarships helping SPHS grads to obtain undergraduate educations.



## Mildred Keith Stiles (Class of 1910)

The gift from Keith Stiles' estate also memorializes Keith's mother, Mildred Keith Stiles, a SPHS grad in the Class of 1910. Mildred was born in 1892 and married Keith's father, Conrad Stiles. She passed away in 1961 and rests in the San Gabriel Cemetery.

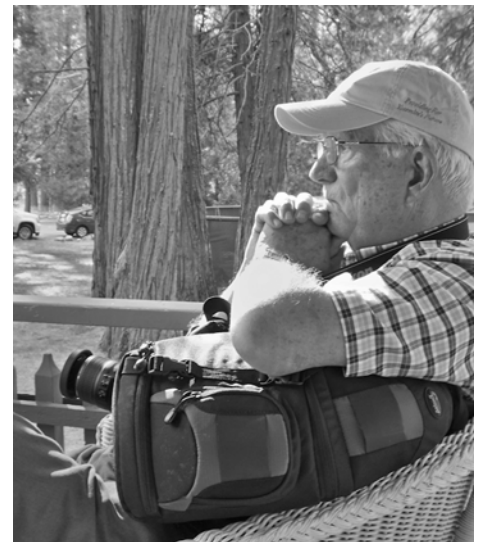
