SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Only graduating seniors may apply for the following scholarship:

The applicant must be planning to attend a community college, 4-year college or university, nursing, trade or vocational school to pursue either training in a trade or a Bachelors Degree.

Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of:

1. Financial need
2. Scholastic Record
3. School extra-curricular activities
4. Community services and activities
5. Work experience.

Special attention will be given to the amount of time an applicant works during the academic year, with the understanding that hours spent at work may adversely affect grade point average and the opportunity to participate in extra-curricular activities.

Semifinalist applicants will be invited for an oral interview. Winners will be announced at the Senior Awards Night.

Directions:

- Type or use black ink
- Submit a transcript with the application
- Deadline – Due no later than WEDNESDAY BEFORE SPRING BREAK.
- Return completed application to the Students Service Office by brunch
- Answer all questions on the application with no attachments other than transcript and proof of earnings. Please remove any Social Security numbers (darken or white out).

Give the name of a SPHS faculty member as a reference.

List your school extra-curricular activities: athletics, leadership, band, choir, drama, cheerleading, newspaper/yearbook, etc. Also list any athletic or academic awards received.

List your community activities (boy/girl scouts, etc.), community services and volunteer activities. List each activity and the number of hours spent on them during your high school years. DO NOT INCLUDE COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION.

List your work experience during your high school years. Who were your employers? How long did you work for each employer? How many hours each week did you work? What were your duties? What skills did you learn from your work experience?

What you do in the classroom defines only a part of who you are. How do you spend your time when you are not in class or studying? Discuss what you have gained in life from your activities outside of the classroom.

Describe briefly what you plan to do with your education.

Reflecting on your family experiences and personal circumstances, what would you like to tell us that is not already explained or revealed in your application? Discuss any unusual circumstances or challenges you have faced and the ways that you have responded to them.

Were there any times during your high school years when you had an opportunity to befriend, help or mentor one of your fellow students realizing that the only reward that you would receive was knowing that you had helped a fellow student? Discuss.
