

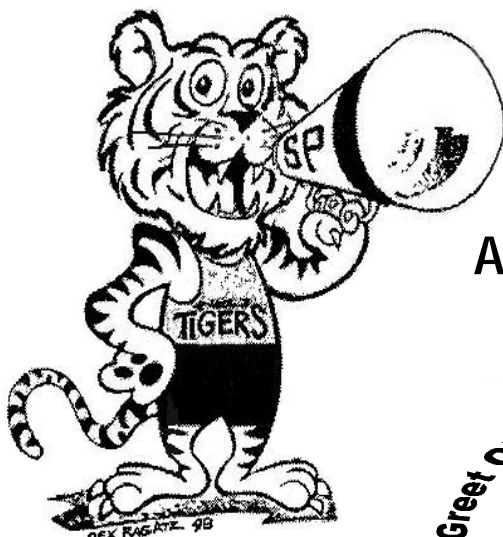

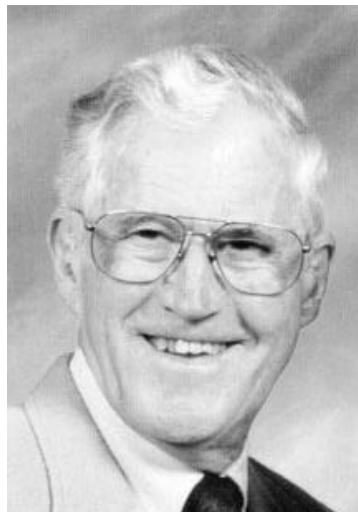

Thomas P. Bryce 1919 - 2003

Over 200 friends and relatives attended memorial services for Thomas P. Bryce, class of '37, on January 25, 2003, at the United Methodist Church of South Pasadena. Tom passed away on January 7th.

Tom was a lifelong resident of South Pasadena. He attended Lincoln Elementary School, South Pasadena Junior and Senior High Schools.

Tom was Grand Marshal in the South Pasadena Fourth of July Parade one year and also was the designated "King" of the 2002 Grand Reunion III.



Tom is survived by his wife of 61 years, Mary (Deniston) Bryce, '38, son Brad Bryce, '68, Brad's wife, Claudia, and step-grandchildren, Dior Chase, '86, Marko Chase, '88, and Marco's wife, Erin (Wardlow) Chase, '89.

Tom Bryce served as a dedicated member of the Alumni Association and was Chairman of the Scholarship Committee for several years. He was very proud of the number of scholarships that were awarded each year to deserving graduating high school seniors.

Our reason for being is stated in the bullets above. We need your continued support, both financially and by communicating with us, to meet those objectives.

It is our policy that we do not give your personal information

to anyone except designated reunion coordinators. If we get a request for the name or address of any classmate, we will forward the request to that classmate to respond as they choose.

This year we have included an insert in the center of this publication to make it easier for you to respond to us. Our database of alumni includes over 16,000 names but that does not include the entire list of alumni. This publication is sent to all alumni for whom we have a valid address. Tiger Tales, which is published in the

fall is sent only to dues paying members. We have no way to reach alumni who are not on our list other than by referral. That is where you can help.

Your dues are used for the printing and mailing of our publications and to provide for the necessary operating expenses of the Association. Your donations are used to fund scholarships – our primary reason for being. Donations are fully tax deductible

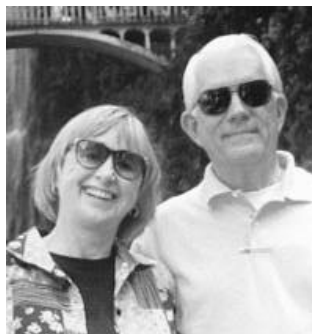

SCHOLARSHIP NEWS

One of the major purposes of your South Pasadena High School Alumni Association is to award scholarships to South Pasadena High School graduates who continue their education beyond high school. Over 95 percent of South Pasadena High School graduates continue on to college. We have been able in recent years to award about \$40,000 per year to graduates due to your contributions.

All money received for scholarships is only used for scholarships and is not used to fund the Alumni Association costs.

Scholarships are awarded based on financial need, scholastic record, school extra curricular activities, community service and work experience. Scholarship winners receive their awards only after they have provided the Alumni Association Treasurer proof of college registration.
