\$800,000 Needed for New Track and Field at High School

Concerned about twisted ankles, shin splints, and concussions, Board of Education member Don Eggleston, right, has launched an ambitious campaign to raise funds for an artificial football/soccer field and new Olympic calibre track at South Pasadena High School. To date, Eggleston says about \$111,250 has been raised toward the project which costs approximately \$1.6 million for both the field and track. Eggleston points out that San Marino, La Canada, Arcadia, and St. Francis high schools all have artificial fields, similar to what was played on at this year's Super Bowl. Eggleston says about \$700,000 has been lined up once South Pasadena's project gets started. "We need to secure a donation of \$800,000 in order for the project to move forward," he said.

Organizations involved in the funding include the SPHS booster club, AYSO, Pasadena Poly, Kiwanis, Mayfield Sr. School, Holy Family, and private parties. "If we get the pledge of \$800,000 by the end of May, the project could move forward this spring and summer and be ready for this fall's football season," said Eggleston. "It would look great all the time, not just for graduation at the high school. The PE students could exercise on the track just after it rained, instead of having PE canceled for that day."

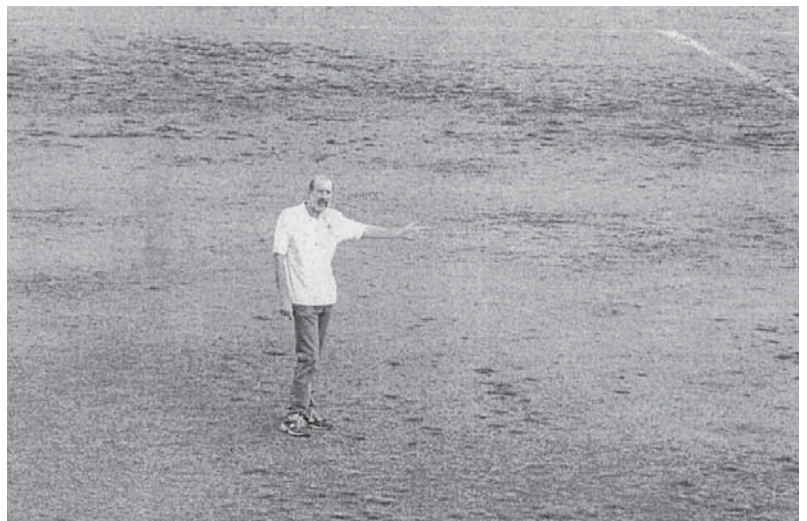

Eggleston insists the fundraising for the project is entirely publicly funded. Eggleston is standing in the middle of the field which he says is in no condition to play on, following the football and soccer season at the high school.

3. **To maintain a directory of SPHS graduates and to coordinate reunion activities.**

Our Master list of alumni contains over 18,000 names. The information maintained includes member number, class year, names, mailing addresses, email address, phone numbers and status of your membership in the Association. The information is used for mailing our publications and to provide class member lists to reunion committees.

4. **To preserve SPHS memorabilia.**

From time to time we receive various items from alumni or the families of deceased alumni. We work with the High School and the South Pasadena Public Library to determine an appropriate disposition of such items such as collection, display, storage or disposal.

5. **To cultivate the heritage and dignify the traditions of SPHS.**

We document, communicate, preserve or otherwise take actions which serve to fulfill this objective as seems appropriate.
