All we ask is that if you're not already a member, please take the time to write us just one small check each year and become a member.

Would it be easier for you if we enabled you to pay by credit card or automatic deduction? If so, let us know and we'll set it up.

We have been told that we are one of the best high school alumni associations in the country. We could be many times better if more of you joined in.

Please consider it. There is an envelope in the center fold and if you join or renew before July 1st, you can use the old rate of \$10.00 a year for as many years as you want. # History, Genealogy and South Pasadena High

Millions of people log onto family history websites every day in search of their ancestral roots."*

Finding what's become of some of our LOST alumni has taken all the resources and ingenuity of a genealogy sleuth. Asking former classmates to find their friends has brought limited success, as they often respond, "Their parents are still in the same house." Fine, but we on the Alumni board don't know who they are nor where they lived. "Her brothers would know how to reach her." Sure, and who might they be, and where are they? Maybe in the house with the same parents we don't know! So we started sending out emails to all the people with the same last name, asking if anyone knew these missing graduates. (You many have gotten one--thanks for your help!) The responses were fast and fascinating. We didn't always get information about the people we were looking for but we're starting to know better whom to ask when someone in the same family goes missing on us.

In the same way that computer technology has made our job of maintaining the ever-growing mailing list more manageable, finding and documenting our Lost or Deceased alumni has been greatly enhanced by public vital records now available online, especially here in California.

A regular search of internet archives for obituaries containing the words "South Pasadena" or "San Marino" gives us people who hadn't been reported to us through family and classmates. (Remember, until 1956, the two cities were equally represented at our school.) If the article doesn't mention graduating from the high school, we have to look further to ensure that this was one of our graduates. The Social Security Death Index (aka SSDI) may list several people with the same name, even the same approximate age as our missing graduate, and if it's a woman whose name has changed since graduating, that makes it even more difficult to match against our rosters. Then we have to pull out all the stops. In an extreme case, we may check the California Birth Index (1905-1995), note the mother's maiden name, use that to see who else was born to the same parent last names. Are those siblings the right ages, corresponding to other students we show with that last name? Or the California Death Index (1940-2000) may list her with maiden name and/or her mother's maiden name from the birth index, neither shown in the SSDI, confirming her married name.

Our "missing" from early years includes a number of female graduates whom we've never had address records for and may now be deceased under another name. That same "siblings search" often helps determine who a student was, giving us a birthdate to check against. Sometimes that's enough to find the right listing in the SSDI, but when there are several with the same first name, middle initial and birthdate, and especially when they remained in California long enough, there is more we can check. If it falls within the 1949-1985 window of the online California Marriage Index, there may be a married name (or two!) to go by. Children born with that new last name, showing our lady grad's last name as the mother's maiden name, should jibe with the children named in the obituary, sometimes also with the next generation of SPHS Tiger graduates in our database, if they stayed in town. All this helps us not list the wrong person in our Memoriam section. These are the same strategies & public domain resources one can use to

help locate and document one's ancestors.

With this information as to whom our lost graduates married (and didn't tell us--why are we the last to know?!), we may even find tentative addresses for them. There are phone books and address directories online that could list the two people found together in the Marriage index. If both names show up at the same address, it's worth a try, so these good guesses get reported to the class representative for further investigation, and Bingo! Another Bengal is tagged and back in the active files.

It is exciting to puzzle out where people have gone off to, but it's still tough when sad news comes back. A recent search for "South Pasadena" in the obits brought up the Star-News listing of Harold J. Poe (1942-2008), although it was actually a nephew reported as one of the survivors who turned out to be the South Pas graduate that triggered the find. However, Harold was born in Gallup, NM, about the same time as a friend of mine, so I wrote and asked if they had known each other. Sure enough, in a town no larger than ours, they had been neighbors and classmates, and he even admitted to their doing a little mischief together in their youth. Alas, they had lost track after high school, and now this serendipitous connection came too late to renew their childhood ties. It's our hope that all we're doing with the Alumni Association--picnics, reunions, news magazines, web links and more, across years and generations--will help keep our Tigers in touch.

For the rest of you curious genealogy buffs out there, yes, I've even looked up a few older SP-SMHS-ers in the 1900-1920 U.S. census, finding early Tiger families in their original households and neighborhoods. This is exciting when you consider that our first graduating class was 1907 and the 1900 census lists not only names and relations of everyone in the household but also their birthdates. Any holder of an L.A. County Library card can freely access the Heritage Quest census resources. This job is way too much fun!

But apparently missing from our school is the historical record of official class rosters through the years, let alone the population of individual graduates. While the high school and the city library may have a permanent collection of yearbooks and are acquiring a complete set of each year's graduation program, we're taking the initiative to re-create an archive documenting those who frequented the halls of our great alma mater. Like the 1890 National U.S. Census destroyed in a fire at the national archives and now slowly being reconstructed from state, county and church records, we're pulling up all the names we can find from various sources--Copas, programs, reunion rosters and classmates' and siblings' memories--to restore this legacy.

Meanwhile, with each publication mailing and pending reunion, we tackle the never-ending task of keeping contact with our Tigers. Once they're out the door, diploma in hand, it's often too long to wait the 10 years for that first decade's reunion to find everyone again. People have moved on with their lives. By year 20, when they're busy at work, at home with young families, they're not always thinking about their old ties. When the 30th reunion is looming, nostalgia finding a place in their minds, we start to hear more from people once again. If we can stay on top of things, we won't lose so many folks along the way.

Now, back to the future. Reunions are coming up for the "8" and "9" years, the "0" and "1" classes following sooner than you think, not to mention those for the 5-year increment events in-between. While you may have been having 10th, 20th, 25th reunions and beyond, we don't have a class representative or contact on file for some years to work on locating classmates and keeping updated with their contact information. If you know anyone (how about YOU?) who might act as liaison to the Alumni Records, Membership and Reunion Committees for the classes in 1920's, 1930's, 1943, 1947, 1950, 1951, 1962, 1979, 1982, 1990, 1991, 1993-1996, and all the 2000's, please step forward! There's not much involved if we can just keep current.

## William Craig Bullock Joins SPHSAA Board

I was born in Pasadena at Saint Luke's Hospital, November, 1941. My father was also W. Craig Bullock, born on Milan Ave in 1912 and graduated from SPHS in the Class of 1931.

I lived at 1428 Rollin Street in South Pasadena until 1949, then, lived on Fletcher in South Pasadena.

After graduating from South Pasadena High School in 1960, I attended Pasadena City College and took a new curriculum course in aircraft and missile design. This course included drafting, machine shop, math, materials and processes, English and so on.

Near the end of this course, I landed a job at Aerojet-General in Azusa, CA. I ended up assisting a test engineer by the name of Bo Boman. I became his test data reductionist, reading all of the oscillographs and plotting the data for presentation. I never thought too much about it until I later realized that we were making history testing the Apollo lander rocket engines that HAD to fire in order for the Astronauts to leave the Moon! (Yes, we were actually firing the engines down in the rock quarries of Azusa and, Yes, they did go boom at times - that's another story).

I married Sue Curtis '63 in December 1963, sister of Brian Curtis '60. We produced son, Michael, now to be 43 on October 1st.

After a couple of years at Aerojet, I ended up at Leach Corporation. They were in the business of building data tape

recorders for industry and space.

These first two positions marked the start of a very rewarding and exciting career in engineering for me. I became a senior draftsman, senior mechanical designer, printed circuit board designer and product designer prior to entering management where I ran all of engineering services for several companies along with three startup companies. I was also one of 12 associates involved in the design of the world's first walking robot known as ODEX. This robot was introduced to the world in 1983.

Odex is now in the American History Museum of the Smithsonian. I also hold three patents for design that belong to several companies.

After 35 years in engineering, I switched to program management where I was responsible for several space projects, one of them being equipment on board the space shuttle.

I am presently working full time as the Director of Engineering for a contract furniture manufacturing company in North Long Beach, CA.

I will be assisting in as many SPHSAA projects as possible in order to learn all aspects of the operation.

## Field of Dreams Becomes a Reality at South Pas High

Without a doubt, South Pasadena Unified School District Superintendent Brian Bristol said Friday evening will be one of the most exciting of his life.

"The chance to see years of dedication and commitment of the community coming to fruition is thrilling,"

said Bristol, looking ahead to the unveiling of the new artificial field and all-weather track at South Pasadena High School. "This marks a great new era of cooperation and commitment on the school district's and the community's part to make sure we have quality facilities for everyone."

A special halftime ceremony was planned to officially christen the new state-of-the-art facility that is getting its share of accolades for its design. Before then, however, South Pasadena and La Canada High Schools gave the new playing surface a workout as they put it through a solid test.

The fundraising effort involved many in the community who have contributed thousands toward the project, spearheaded by Don Eggleston, a member of the South Pasadena school board, who worked closely with a committee to generate more than 1.4 million. The school district kicked in another 1.5 million from

Measure M funds, bringing the total to \$2.9M. Support has come from the local school board to make massive improvements to the school's baseball field which is estimated to cost about \$600,000. The school board approved \$250,000 toward the effort. The board discussed and approved funding sources for the remainder of the baseball portion of the project during last October's school board meeting. District officials say work on the baseball field was completed in February.
