

SPHSAA contracts for alumni directory

From Tiger Tales, Fall 2004 Issue

Your Alumni Association has contracted with Harris Publishing to produce an all year alumni directory at no cost to the association. One letter and two followup cards have been sent. If you have not called yet, Harris will be calling you soon.

Please be aware that you may choose not to be included in this directory. However, you must advise the publisher of your choice. That will not affect your inclusion in our database. We will not jeopardize your privacy if you wish your information withheld from the directory.

For almost four decades, Harris Publishing has been helping schools and associations leverage the power of alumni support. Harris has worked with high schools, school districts and alumni associations in California and throughout the country, building and enhancing alumni databases. Harris originated the concept of publishing alumni directories for educational institutions at no cost, initially focusing its efforts on the needs of colleges and universities. Harris later broadened its program to meet the growing needs of public high schools, their alumni associations and educational foundations.

To date, Harris has published directories for alumni of more than 1,800 public high schools nationwide.

Harris's extensive research process will hopefully find the current whereabouts of many of our LOST alumni. They will verify the information and collect additional information including, occupation/business, spouse, children's names and e-mail address. All of the updated information will be published, unless you opt out, in a first-rate alumni directory. By finding our lost alumni we hope to be able to increase our Association membership.

As of April 23rd, 2005, 5342 alumni have been validated by phone and 1615 directories have been purchased

At the conclusion of the project, SPHSAA will receive all of the updated information in a computerized form to enable us to update our current database. We also receive a commission on sales.

Alumni may purchase and reserve your copy of the directory when you call to validate your information. The directory will **not** be available for purchase after completion of the project and is not available to non-alumni.

Your Alumni Association was formed in 1982 to provide five main functions for the alumni of South Pasadena High School.

1. To promote, manage and award scholarship funds for deserving students.

Two publications are printed and mailed each year:

Tiger News (this magazine) to inform all alumni of the activities of the Association and to inform of upcoming events.

Tiger Tales is a compilation of reunion reports, tales from alumni and obituaries of those who have passed on during the previous year.

Web site - a new medium to us to provide basic information about the Association, Class activities and news of events, past, present and comming. Check it out at www.sphsaa.org.

3. To maintain a directory of SPHS graduates and to coordinate reunion activities.

Our Master list of alumni contains over 18,000 names. The information maintained includes member number, class year, names, mailing addresses, email address, phone numbers and status of your membership in the Association. The information is used for mailing our publications and to provide class member lists to reunion committees.

This year we have undertaken to provide a hard bound directory of all known alumni Please read the article on the previous page.

4. To preserve SPHS memorabilia.

From time to time we receive various items from alumni or the families of deceased alumni. We work with the High school and the South Pasadena Public Library to determine an appropriate disposition of such items such as collection, display storage or disposal.

5. To cultivate the heritage and dignify the traditions of SPHS.

We document, communicate, preserve or otherwise take actions which serve to fulfill this objective as seems appropriate.
